Real Festival is currently seeking volunteers with an interest in performance to rise to new heights and take part in a very special once in a lifetime project.

All That We Are (Todo lo que Somos)

A collaboration between Australia and Spain.

Bringing a specially choreographed representation of the great diversity of Western Sydney, this show will take performers (and audiences) on a journey, starting as a procession on the ground and then soaring up above the Nepean River suspended by a crane.

Working closely with a professional stunt rigging team, we are looking for people wanting to push their comfort zone and soar high in what will be a rare ground-breaking performance in front of a giant crowd.

In this once in a lifetime opportunity, you will receive training from a professional team of Spanish and Australian stunt directors, learn simple performance choreography and get to work and perform within an exciting festival environment.

We are looking for people to perform both in the air and on the ground, so please still apply if you're not sure about working at height!

We strongly encourage people of all ethnic backgrounds or first nation peoples to apply. The project aims to bring together as much of the diverse cultural representation of Western Sydney as possible in a celebration of unity!

All ages can apply, though only persons over 18 will be able to fly.

About the Festival

Real Festival (River, Environment, Arts & Lifestyle Festival) is Western Sydney's premier arts and lifestyle festival, taking place over the first weekend of November and situated on the banks of the beautiful Nepean River.

Now in its fourth year and with an anticipated audience of 25,000 across the two days of the festival, this is a rare opportunity to perform in one of the most exciting event spectacles to take place in Western Sydney.

Skill Requirements

There are no prior skill requirements for this project. Everyone will be given training through the course of the project rehearsals. The performance movements will be simple and easy to remember.

Comfortability working at height is essential for some! There are ground performer positions available also for those who would rather keep their feet on the ground.
